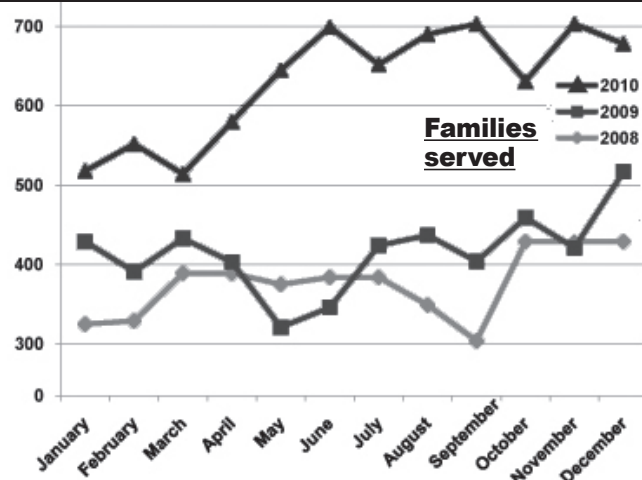

What is SW HOPE: Feed the Hungry?

Local faith communities, businesses and community organizations are working together to meet the needs of hungry people in SW Portland.

What is the Need?



The continued economic downturn means the number of families seeking food assistance in SW Portland has risen to a level we've never seen before. In 2008, the number of families receiving an emergency food box averaged 370 each month; in 2010, that number nearly doubled to approximately 700 families seeking emergency food assistance from Neighborhood House each month. And more than half the food we distribute goes to children and seniors, the groups most vulnerable to consequences of an inadequate diet.



What is the Goal?

Through our combined efforts, our goal is to collect 150,000 pounds of food, or the cash equivalent (\$1= 5 lbs.). This will allow us to feed our hungry neighbors in Southwest Portland for 3 months (at current usage level).

We must stand by our neighbors at this time of extraordinary need.

"This is the first time I've received emergency food (in January 2011). Neighborhood House has given me faith in knowing that we will make it through the month without worry that we will go hungry. Also, knowing that I will go to work having something to keep my strength up gives me assurance that I'll be able to make it through the day." – Johnny, 40, family of 3

How You Can Help

The most impactful way to help your hungry neighbors in need is to make a monetary contribution to SW HOPE. Because of our partnership with the Oregon Food Bank, we are able to purchase food at deeply discounted prices, so that every \$1 donated equals at least 5 pounds of food.

You can mail your monetary donation to Neighborhood House directly, or you can give it to a SW HOPE canvasser, as they visit Southwest Portland neighborhoods between March 6-April 17.

(Checks may be made out to Neighborhood House, with "SW HOPE" noted in memo line)

You can also help by donating canned and non-perishable food items.
